### PERENNIAL RYEGRASS

- Cool-season lawn arass
- Medium to dark green color
- Sharp-pointed tip shape
- Narrow blade width



### **KENTUCKY BLUEGRASS**

- Cool-season lawn arass
- Dark blue-green color
- Boat-shaped tip shape
- Narrow to medium blade width



### TALL FESCUE GRASS

- Cool-season lawn arass
- Lighter green color
- Sharp-pointed tip shape
- Medium to broad blade width



### **CREEPING RED** FESCUE GRASS

- Cool-season lawn arass
- Medium to dark green color
- Pointed fine textured tip shape
- Fine blade width
- Spreading growth habit



### CHEWINGS **FESCUE GRASS**

- Medium to dark green color
- Pointed fine textured tip shape
- Fine blade width
- Bunch grass



### HARD FESCUE GRASS

### CRABGRASS

- Light green color
- Coarse leaf blade
- Annual weed
- Reproduces from seed
- Grows in flat, broad clumps that crowd out turfgrasses



### QUACKGRASS

- Light green color
- Coarse leaf blade
- Cold-hardy perennial weed
- Reproduces from seed and underground rhizomes
- More difficult to eliminate than crabgrass
