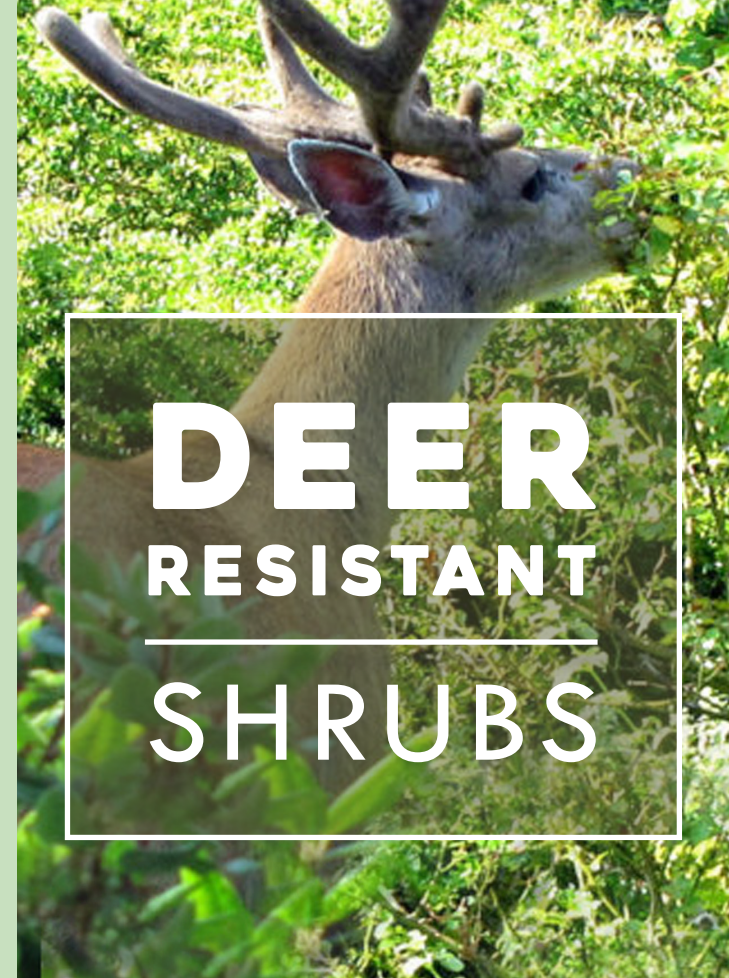
We consider these plants deer resistant — however, some deer are hungrier than others.
