GUIDE TO CUT CHRISTMAS TREES

- Make a straight cut half an inch off the stem
- Use a stand that fits the tree



- PLACE TREE IN WATER ASAP!
- Check the stand daily for water levels – water should not go below the base of the tree and should always cover the cut end
- Keep away from major heat sources (fireplaces, heaters, radiators, heat vents, direct sunlight)
- Low room temperature will slow the drying process & water consumption



- Stands should provide 1 quart of water per inch of stem diameter
- Try using a humidifier to add additional moisture to the room
 - Do not overload circuits!



- Use miniature lights to help reduce the amount of drying
- Always turn off the lights before you leave the house or go to bed
- Replace any old and worn lights with a new set
