

PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS



Completely cover the bottom of the pot with the Lechuza-Pon granulate (supplied).



Add potting soil on top of the Lechuza-Pon granulate.



3 Insert the plant in the pot, and fill the rest of the planter with potting soil.



WATERING INSTRUCTIONS (FOR THE FIRST 12 WEEKS)



* FOR THE FIRST 12 WEEKS:

WATER YOUR PLANT BY POURING WATER
ONTO THE POTTING SOIL AS USUAL

(DO NOT USE THE WATER RESERVOIR YET)

- Do not overwater. Allow your plant to dry completely between waterings.
- Use a moisture meter to help determine when to water your plant.
- Fertilize with every other watering.

After 12 weeks (3 months), your plant's roots will have grown enough to be able to obtain water from the water reservoir.





WATERING INSTRUCTIONS (AFTER THE FIRST 12 WEEKS)



* AFTER 12 WEEKS, BEGIN WATERING VIA THE WATER RESERVOIR ONLY.

Slowly add water to the water reservoir via the water supply shaft until the water level indicator reaches the max level.



DRY PHASE DO NOT ADD WATER WAIT FOR LEVEL TO RETURN TO MIN

Allow the water level indicator to fully return to the min level. Do not add more water until the water level has completely returned back to the min level (about 1-2 weeks depending on the size and type of plant). Please use a moisture meter to ensure that the plant is fully dried out before filling the water reservoir.



Repeat steps 1 and 2, refilling the water reservoir to max via the water supply shaft, followed by another dry phase (allowing the water level to completely return to min before watering again).
