



PREPARE THE AREA

Rake or thatch the area as needed.

ADD TOPSOIL Apply a 0.5" topsoil layer—the Farm at Green Village recommends Fafard Premium Topsoil.



ADD LIME/STARTER FERTILIZER (optional)

The Farm at Green Village recommends Jonathan Green Mag-i-Cal Natural Soil Food and Veri-Green Seeding and Sodding.
