



TOMATO TYPES

DETERMINATE

VS. INDETERMINATE

- Grows to a 'determined' height
- Bushy growth
- Fruit ripens all at once
- Cage support
- Good for short growing season and limited space
- Best for sauces and cooking in large batches

EXAMPLES

- Amish Paste
- Celebrity
- Patio
- Roma
- Rutgers

- Grows to a 'indetermined' height
- Vine growth
- Steady supply, as fruit ripens all season
- Trellis support
- Best for fresh weekly harvests

EXAMPLES

- Beefsteak
- Big Boy
- Brandywine
- Cherokee Purple
- Sungold

Q: WHICH ARE BETTER, DETERMINATE OR INDETERMINATE TOMATOES?

A: Determinate tomatoes are better for sauces and indeterminate tomatoes are best for fresh season-long snacking and slicing. The choice depends on the use of the tomatoes and the length of your growing season.
